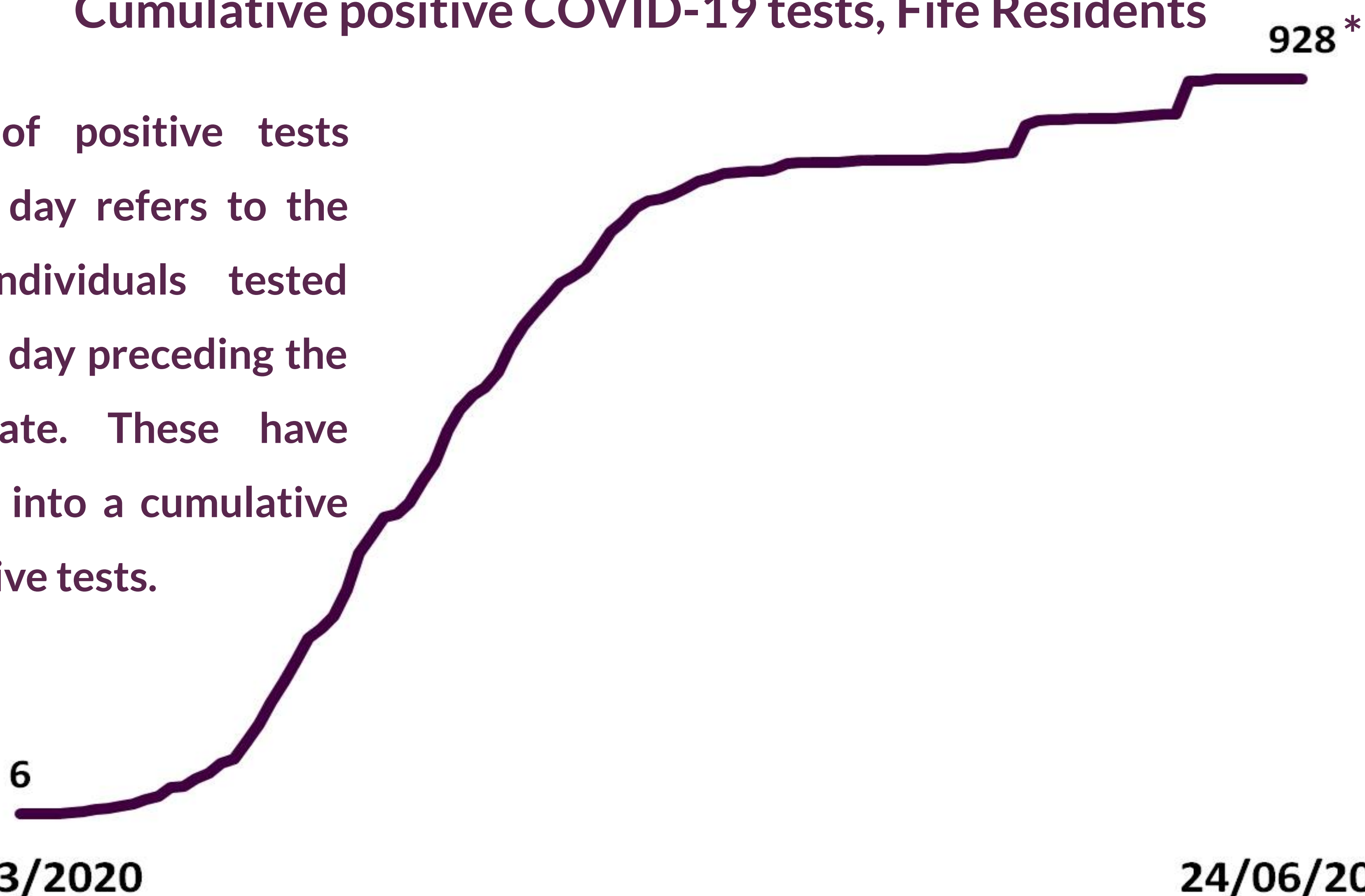

Cumulative positive COVID-19 tests, Fife Residents

The number of positive tests reported each day refers to the number of individuals tested positive on the day preceding the notification date. These have been compiled into a cumulative figure for positive tests.

*The daily total of people found positive on 2/6/20 contains 40 historic samples which accounts for the sharp increase shown in the chart above. The increase on 15 June is due to the addition of all the UK Government testing cases to the database.

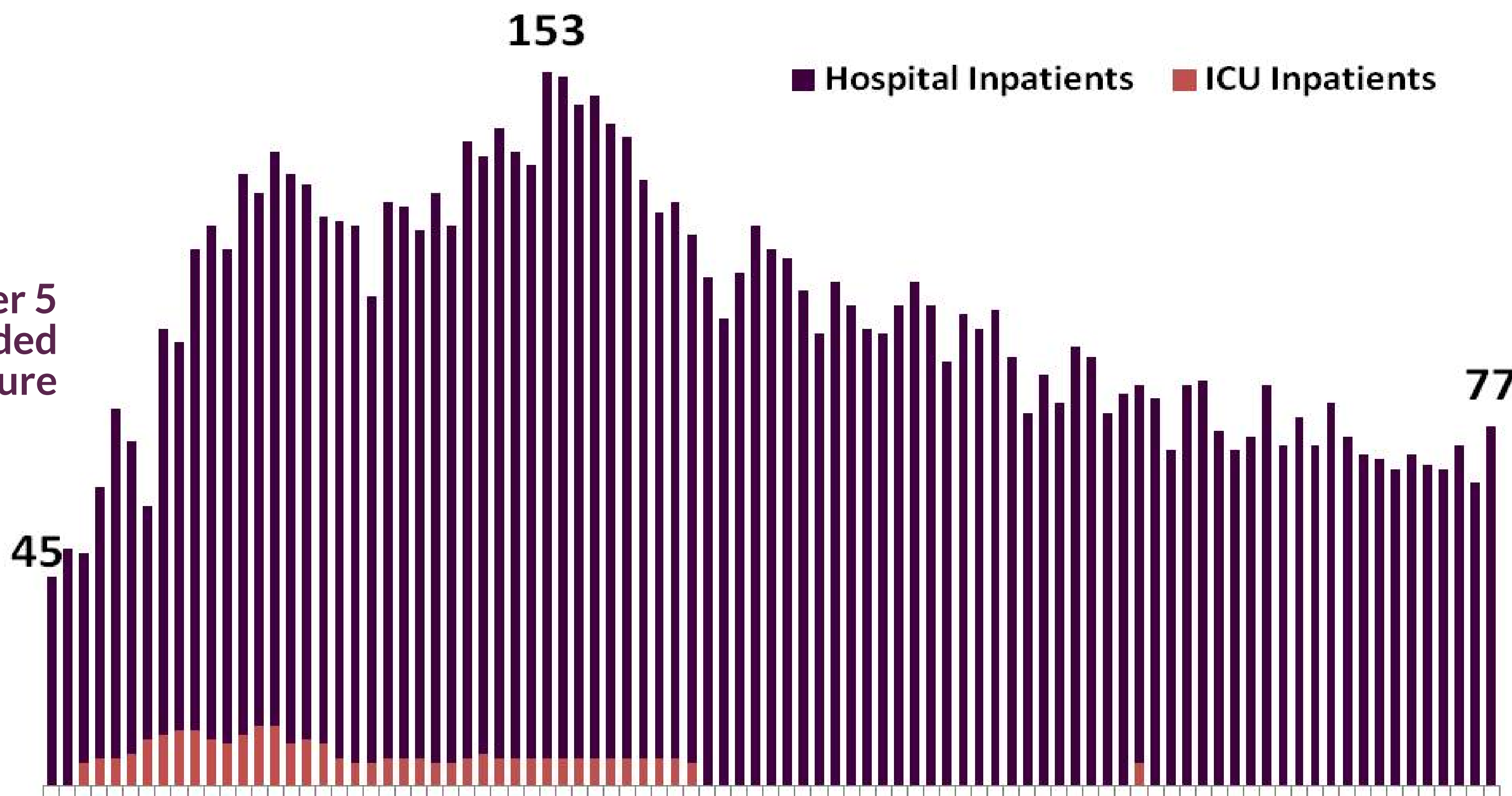
NHS Fife Inpatients with Suspected or Confirmed Covid-19

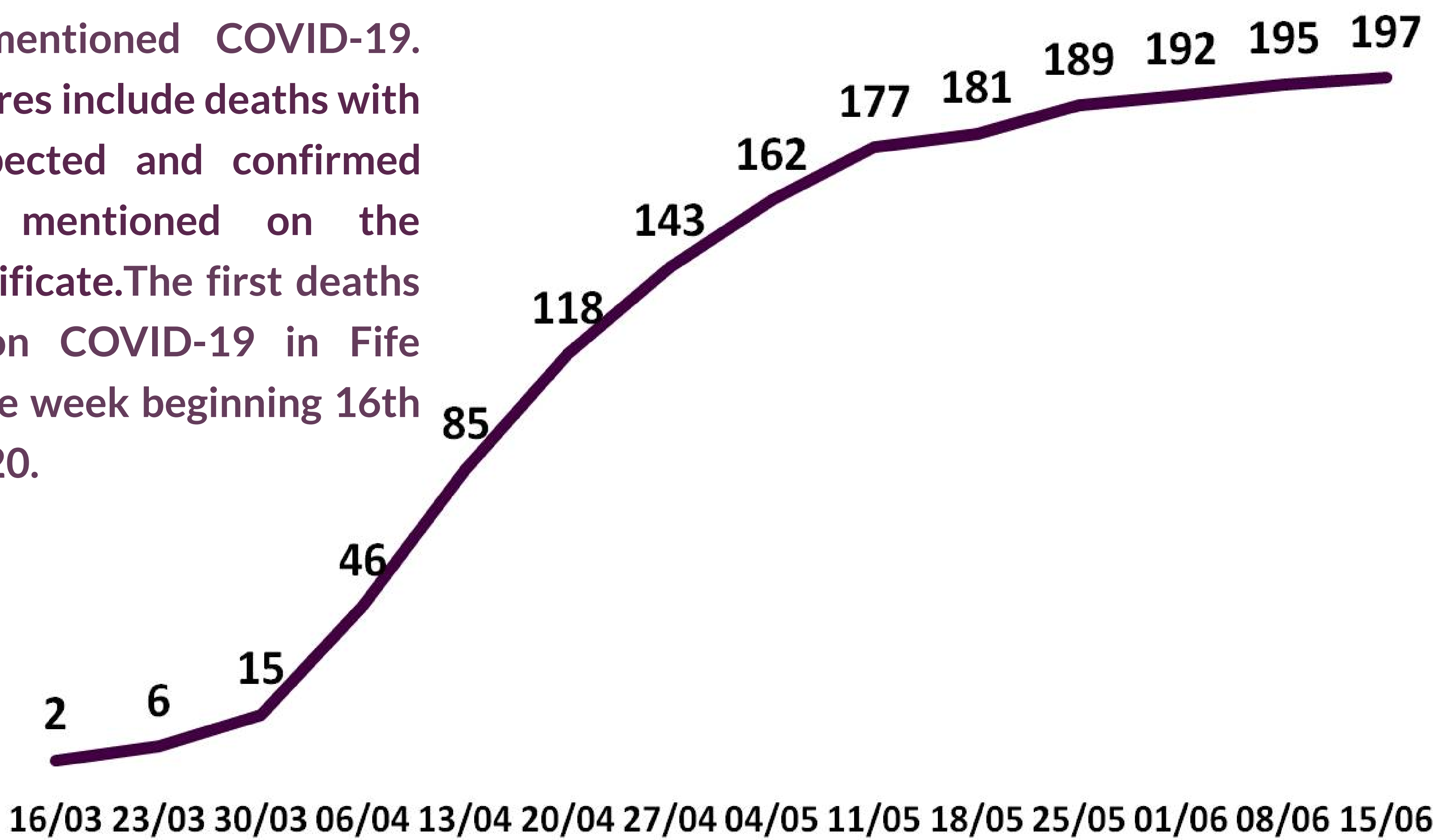

Covid-19 Deaths

Cumulative weekly (provisional) deaths mentioning Covid-19 Fife

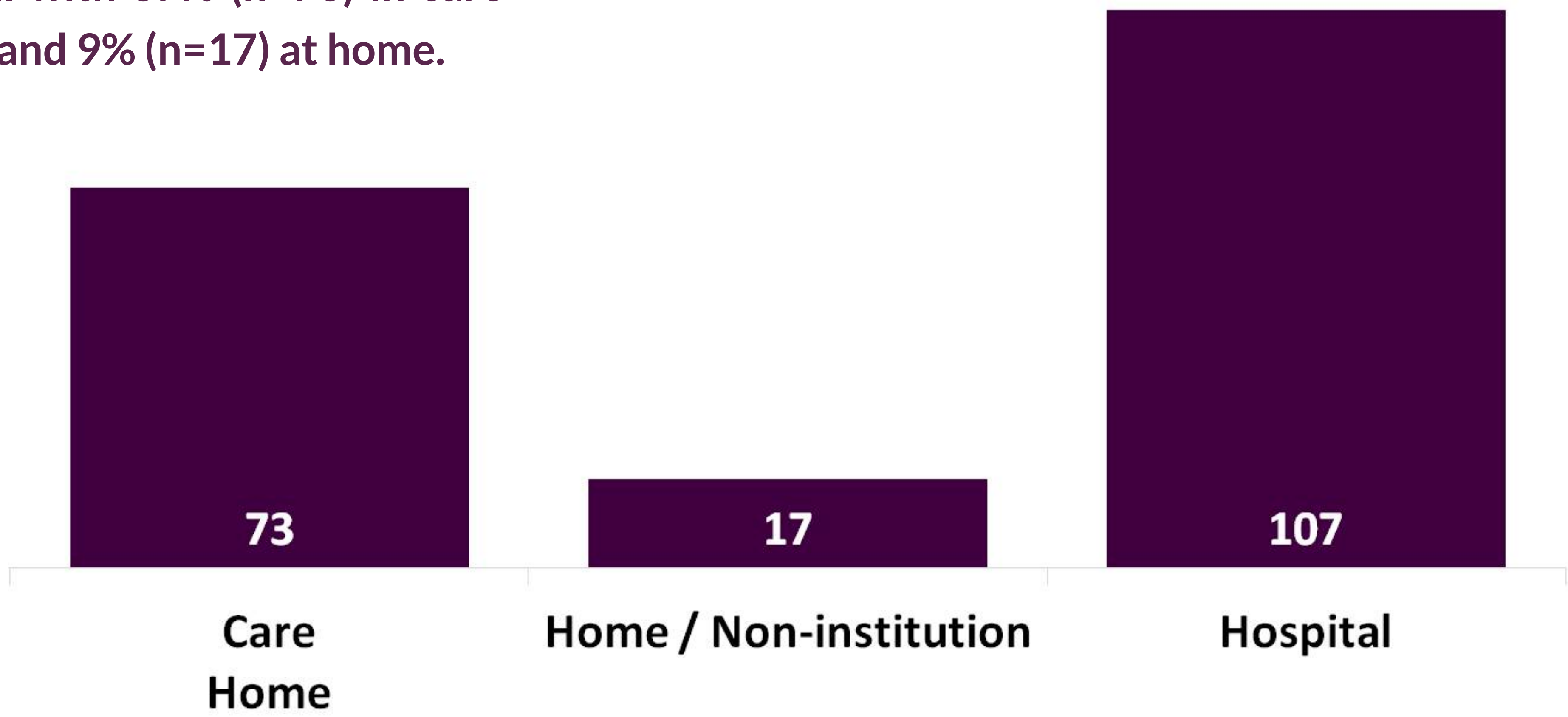
As at 21st June (week beginning 15th June) 197 deaths registered in Fife mentioned COVID-19. These figures include deaths with both suspected and confirmed Covid-19 mentioned on the death certificate. The first deaths to mention COVID-19 in Fife were in the week beginning 16th March 2020.



Covid-19 Deaths by Location

Cumulative weekly (provisional) deaths mentioning Covid-19 Fife by Location

Of the Covid-19 deaths registered to date the majority of deaths (54%, n=107) occurred in hospital with 37% (n=73) in care homes and 9% (n=17) at home.
