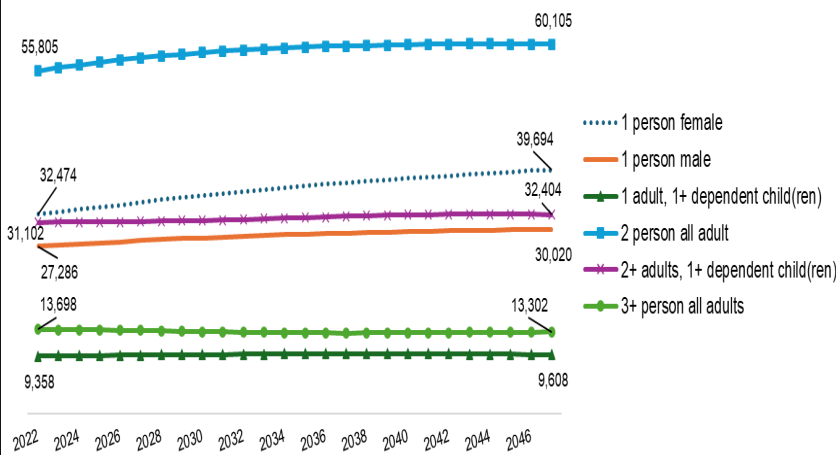

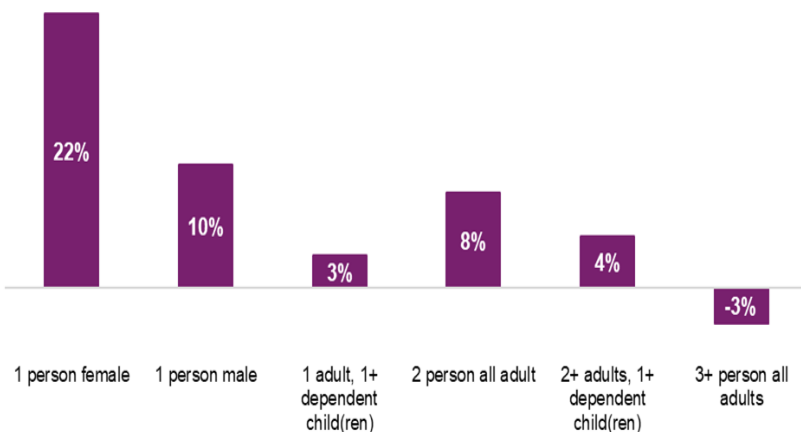

Fife Household Projections per Household Type 2022-2047



- **By 2032** the number of households is expected to **rise by 5%**, which is an increase of 9,139 households.
- **By 2047**, this increase is projected to reach **9%** compared to 2022 (15,410 households).

Percentage Change between 2022 vs 2047 per Household Type Fife



- **Single-person households (especially female) are projected to grow the most.**
- Two person households (without children) also show growth.
- Households with dependent children remain relatively stable.
- **Households with 3+ adults are projected to decline slightly.**
