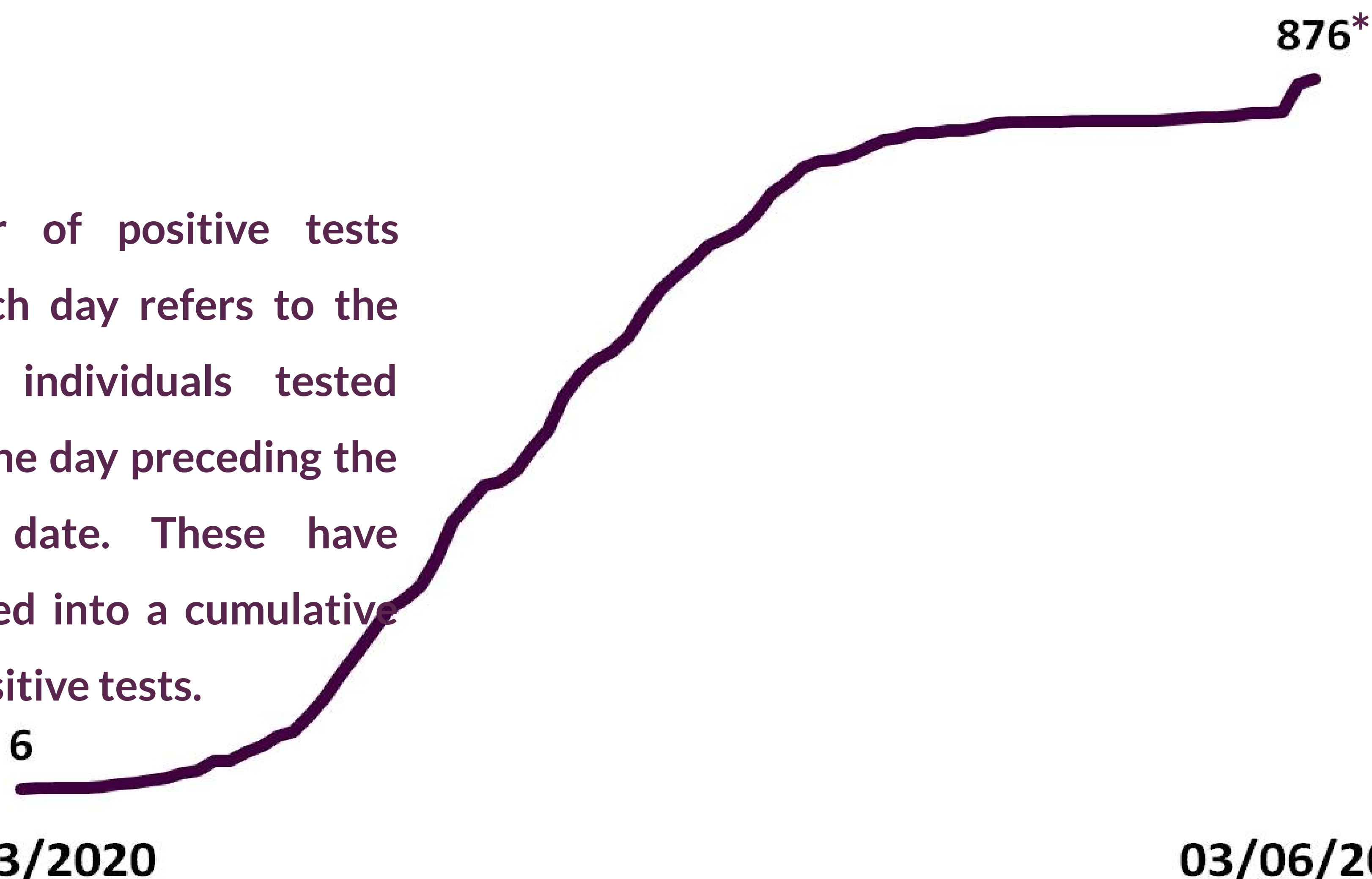

The number of positive tests reported each day refers to the number of individuals tested positive on the day preceding the notification date. These have been compiled into a cumulative figure for positive tests.



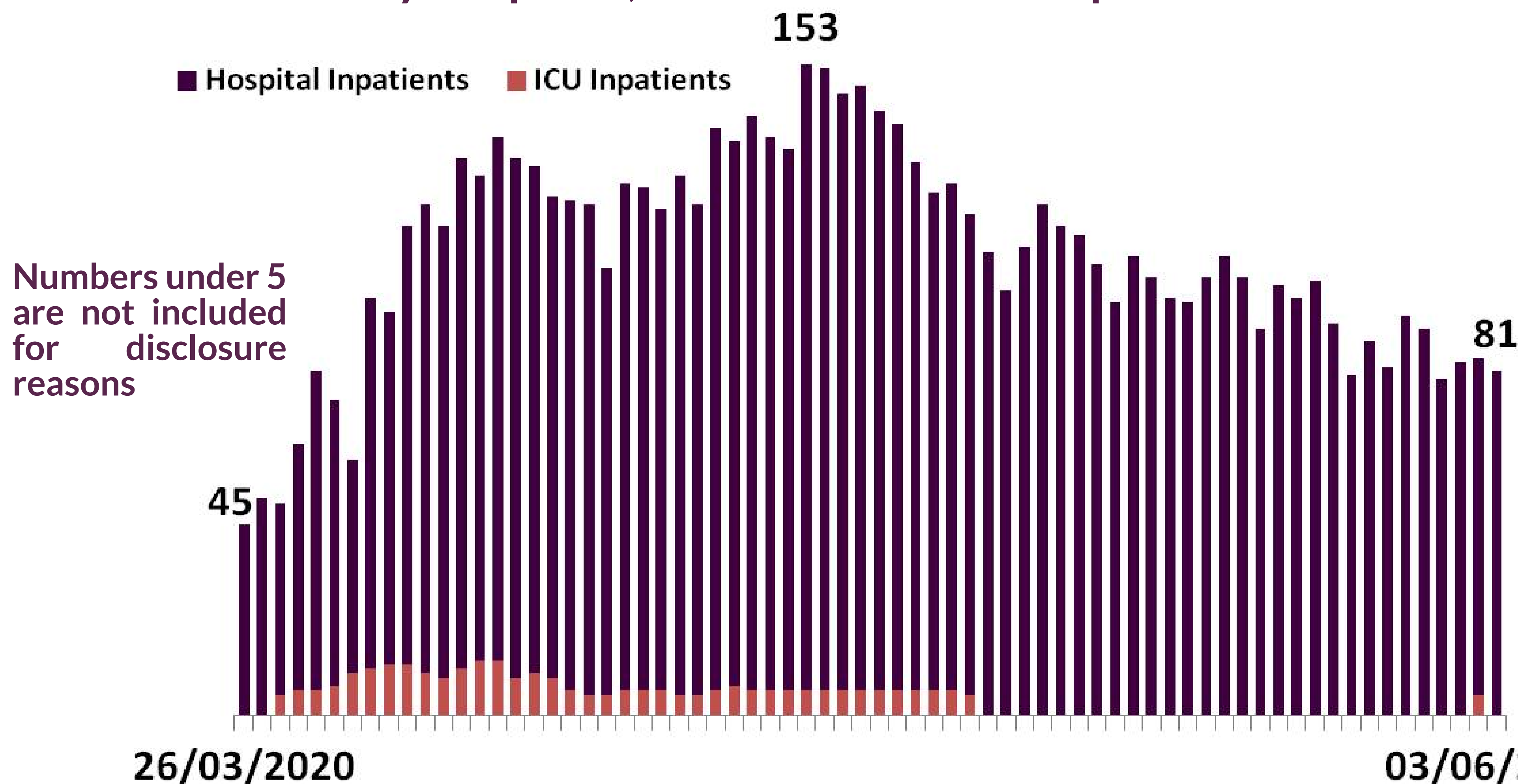

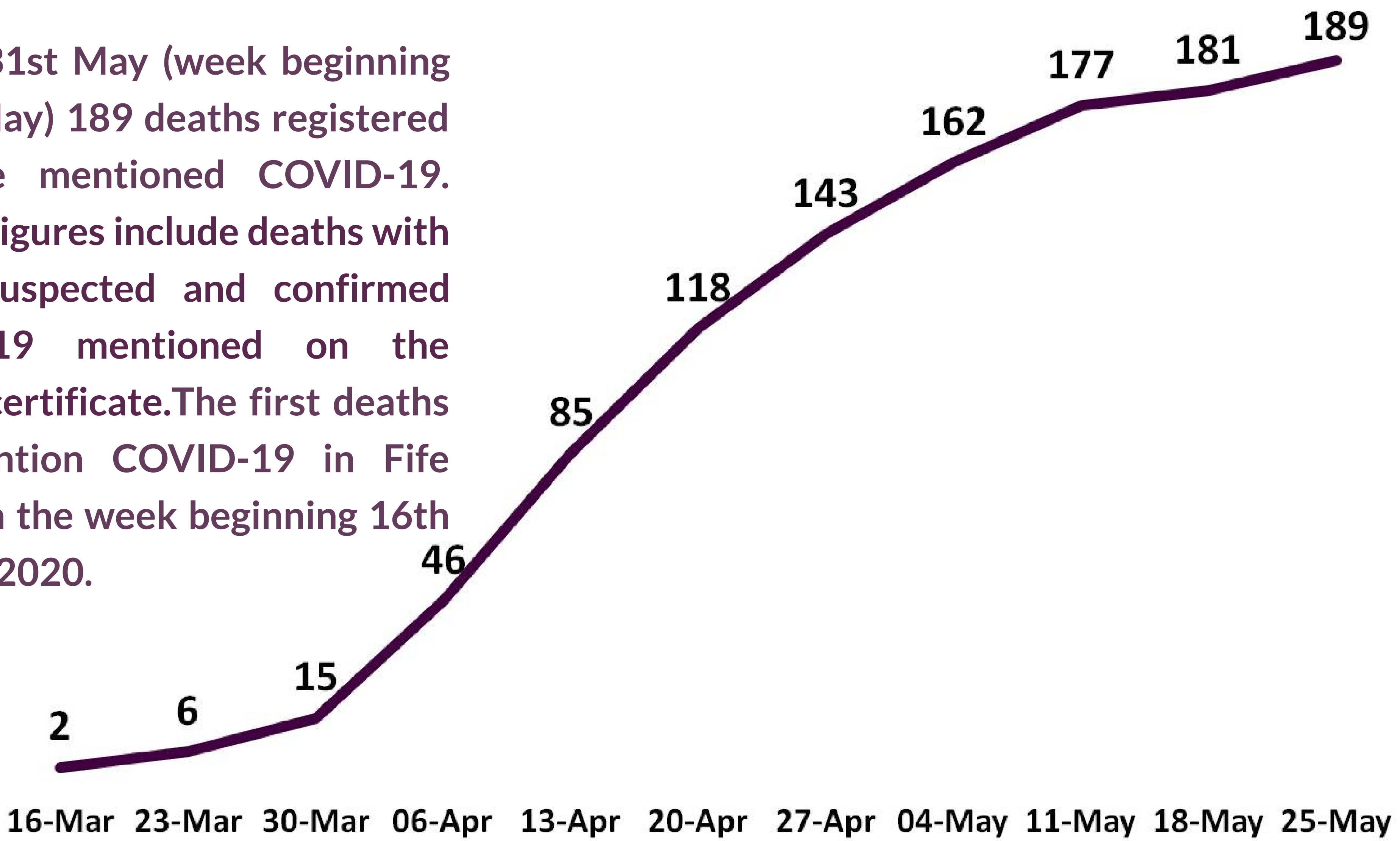

Covid-19 Deaths

Cumulative weekly (provisional) deaths mentioning Covid-19 Fife

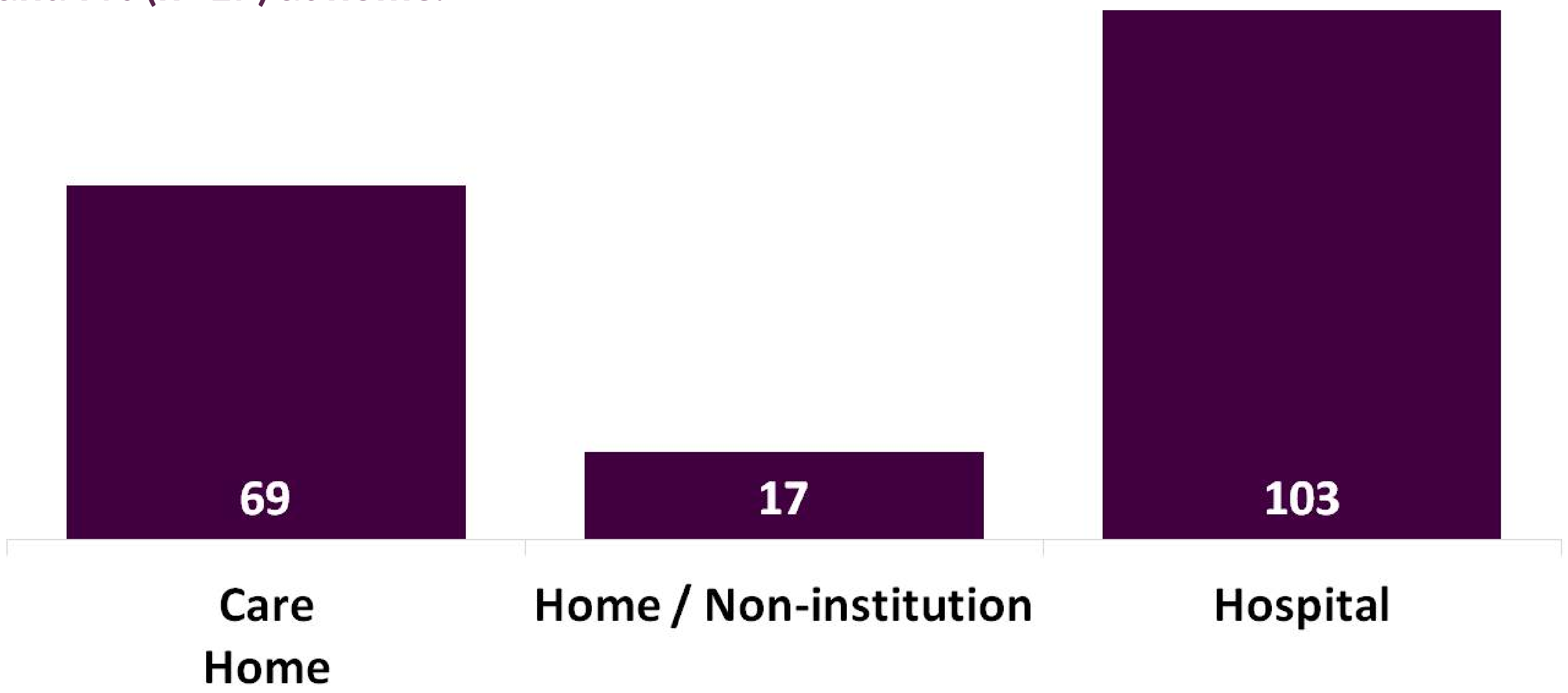
As at 31st May (week beginning 25th May) 189 deaths registered in Fife mentioned COVID-19. These figures include deaths with both suspected and confirmed Covid-19 mentioned on the death certificate. The first deaths to mention COVID-19 in Fife were in the week beginning 16th March 2020.



Covid-19 Deaths by Location

Cumulative weekly (provisional) deaths mentioning Covid-19 Fife by Location

Of the Covid-19 deaths registered to date the majority of deaths (54%, n=103) occurred in hospital with 37% (n=69) in care homes and 9% (n=17) at home.
