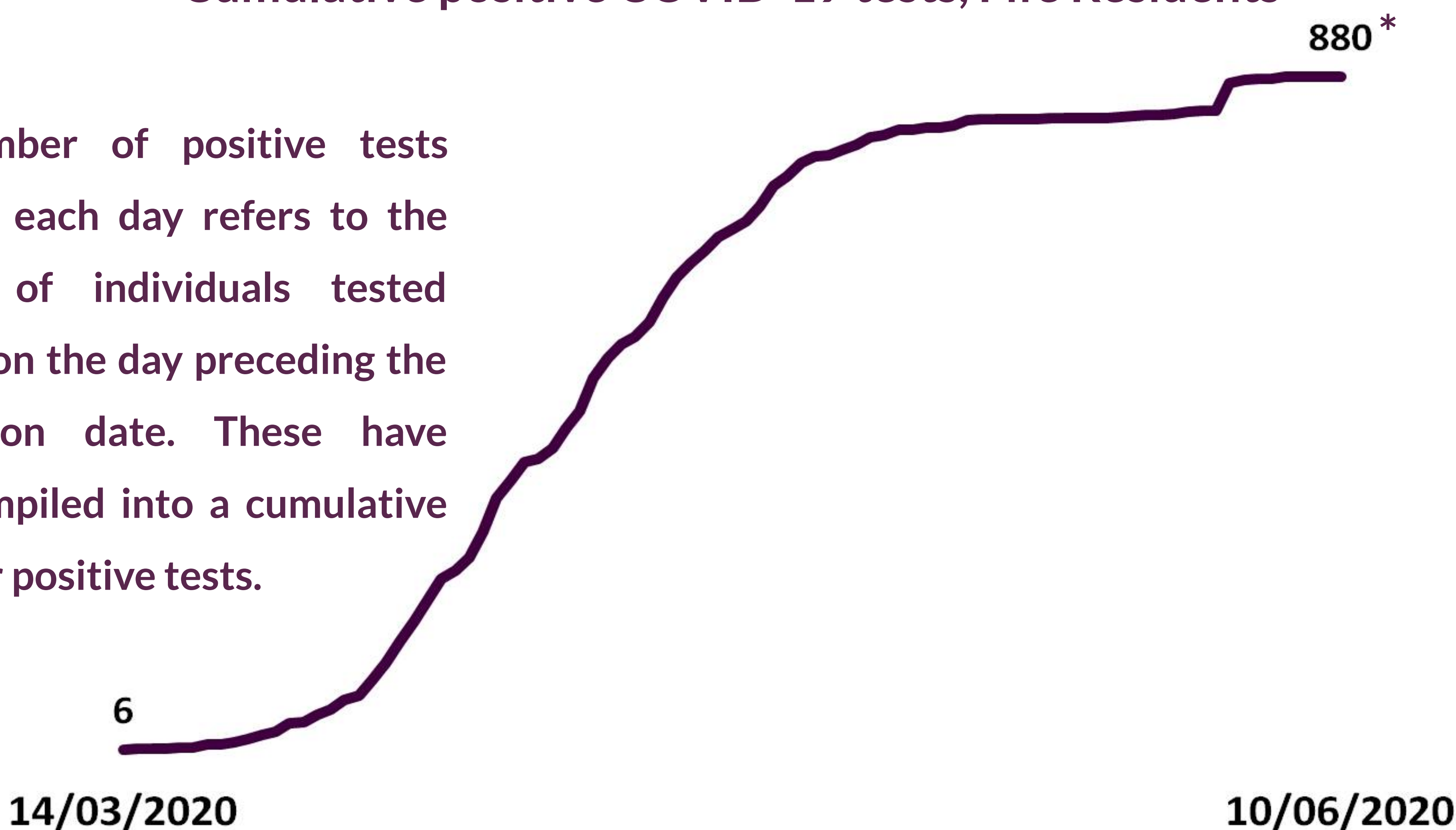

Cumulative positive COVID-19 tests, Fife Residents

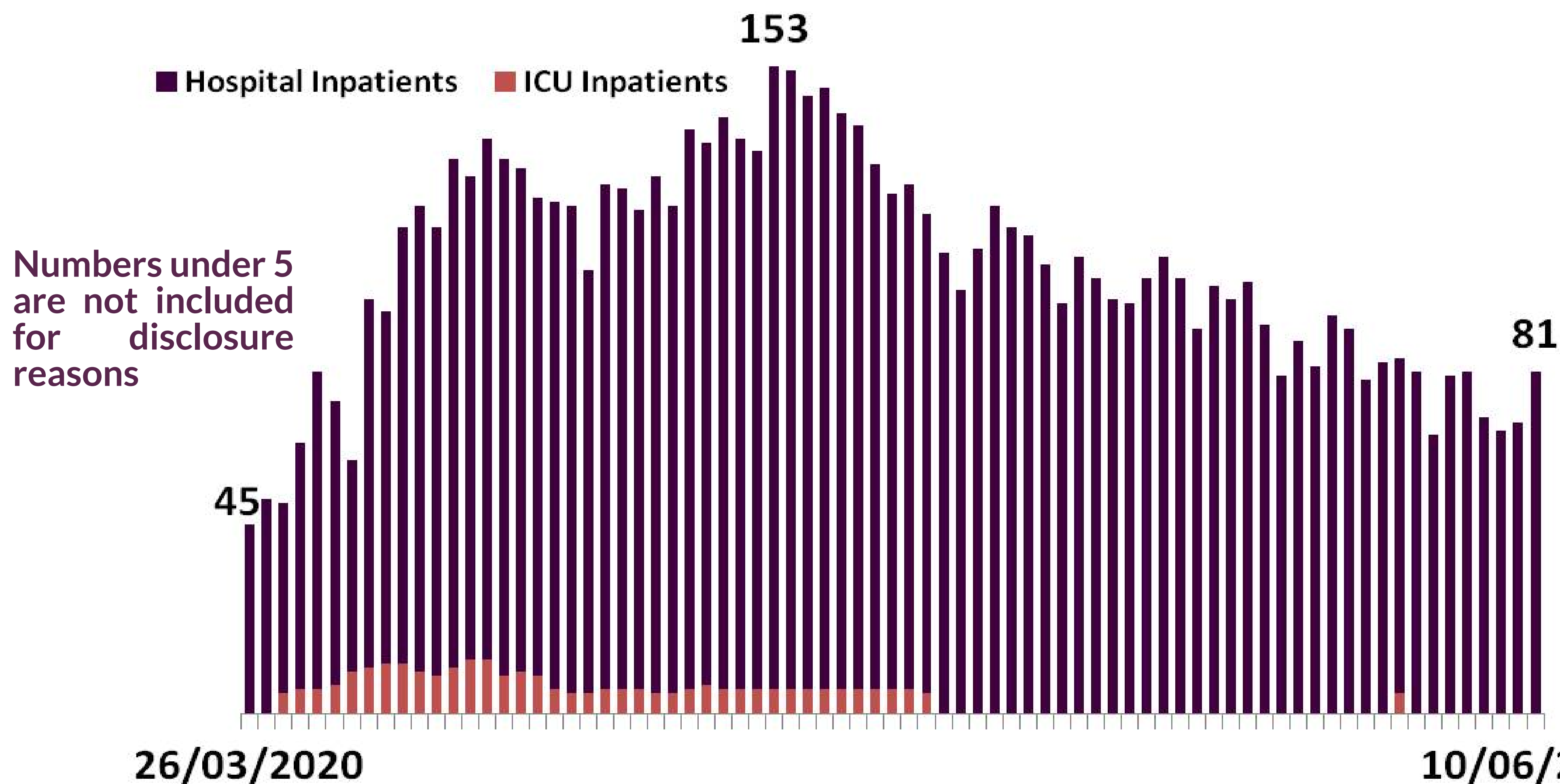
The number of positive tests reported each day refers to the number of individuals tested positive on the day preceding the notification date. These have been compiled into a cumulative figure for positive tests.



*The daily total of people found positive on 2/6/20 contains 40 historic samples which accounts for the sharp increase shown in the chart above

Daily Snapshot, NHS Fife Covid-19 Inpatients

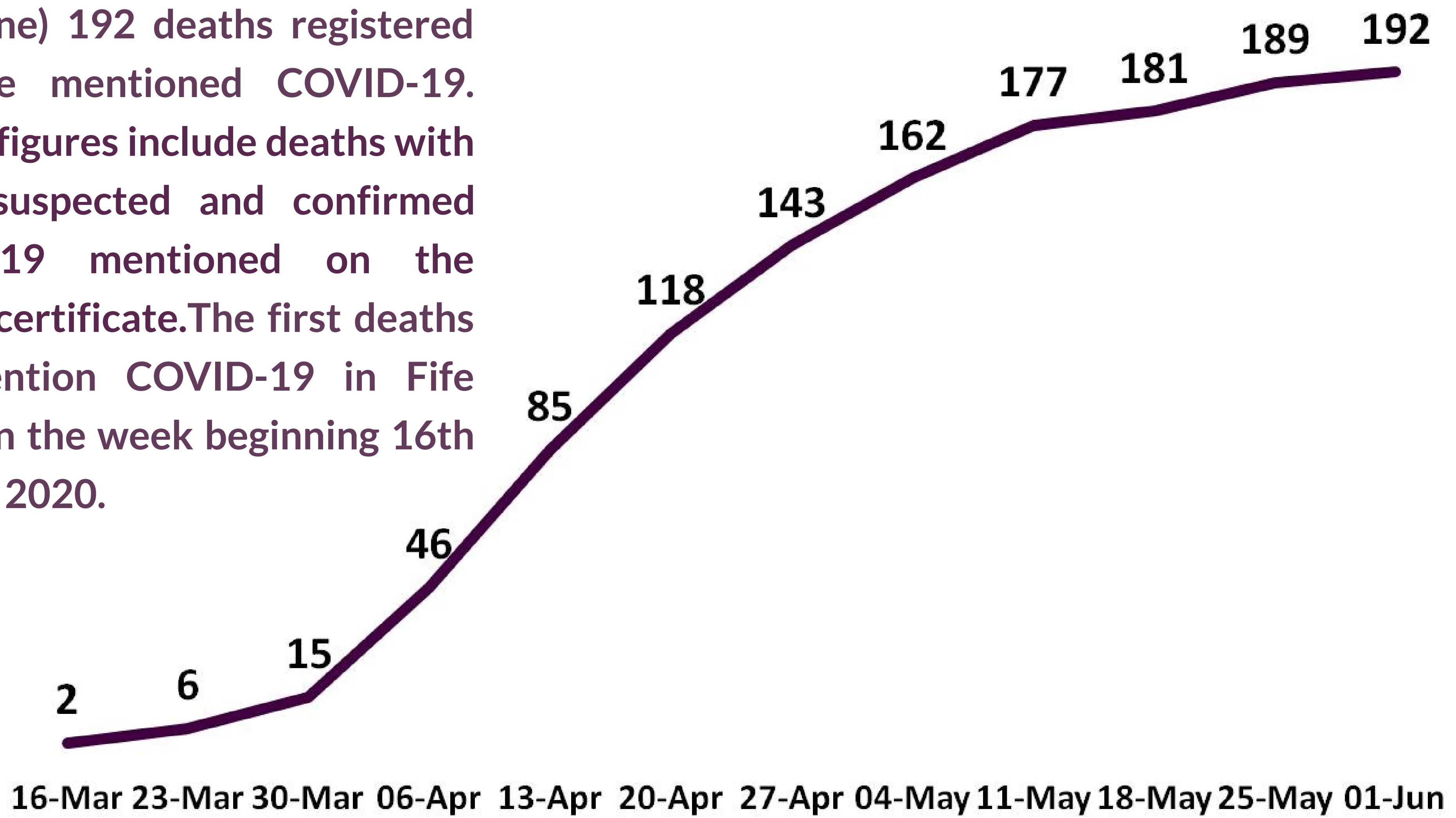

Covid-19 Deaths

Cumulative weekly (provisional) deaths mentioning Covid-19 Fife

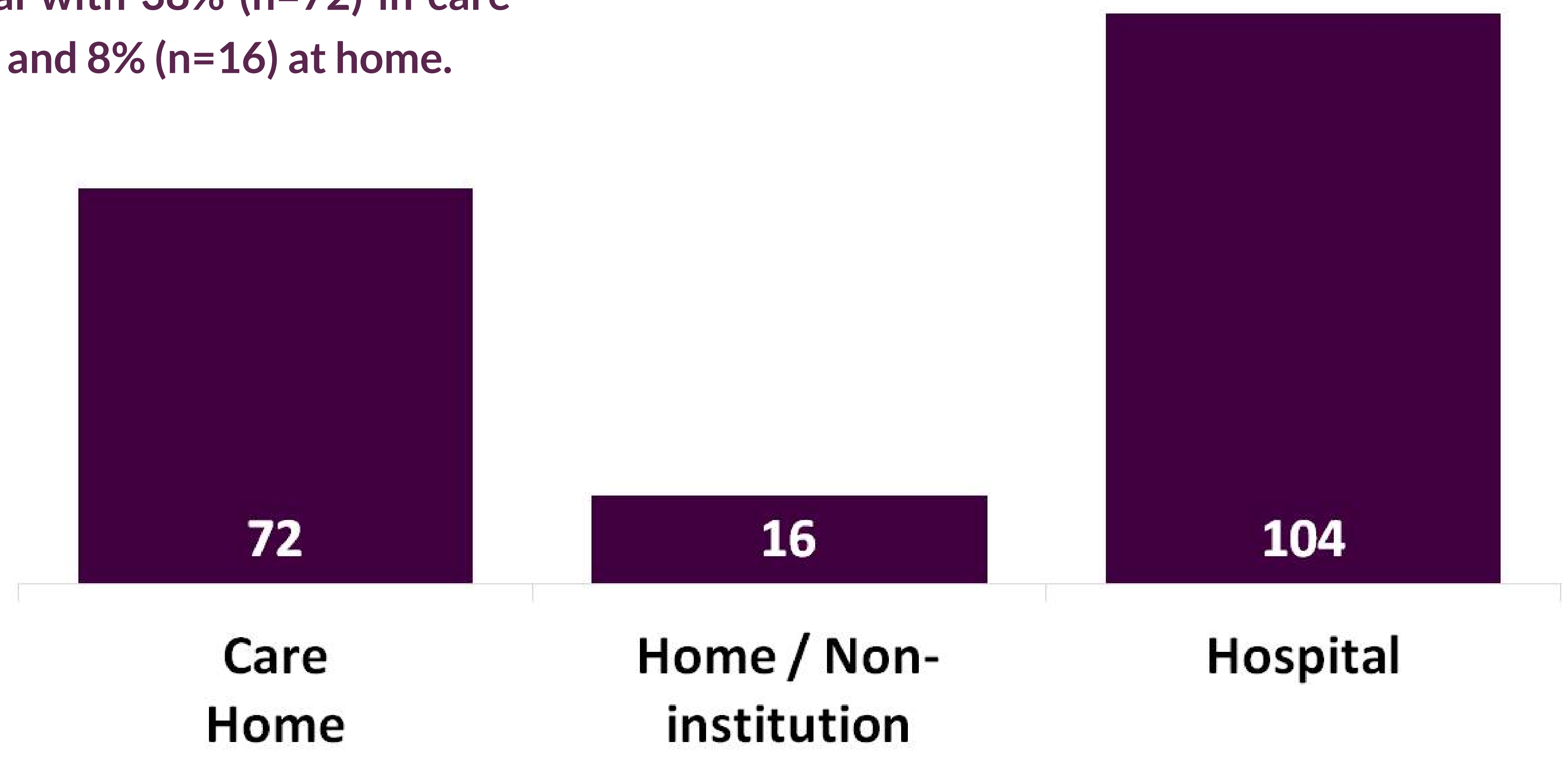
As at 7th June (week beginning 1st June) 192 deaths registered in Fife mentioned COVID-19. These figures include deaths with both suspected and confirmed Covid-19 mentioned on the death certificate. The first deaths to mention COVID-19 in Fife were in the week beginning 16th March 2020.



Covid-19 Deaths by Location

Cumulative weekly (provisional) deaths mentioning Covid-19 Fife by Location

Of the Covid-19 deaths registered to date the majority of deaths (54%, n=104) occurred in hospital with 38% (n=72) in care homes and 8% (n=16) at home.
